These six curriculum areas help our educators to guide and support progress across all areas of development.



Communication and literacy

Speaking, listening, reading and writing are crucial to children's early development. Showing children the importance of language through fun activities and encouraging them to engage with a wide range of texts helps to ignite a lifelong curiosity for learning.



Mathematics

At an early age, it's important to help children recognise how mathematics impacts everyday life. Through games and activities, we can introduce children to mathematical language, thinking and concepts that they will need when they start their primary education.



SECONDARY CURRICULUM

International Programme Diploma Equivalency

Paragon ISC's High School Diploma for the International Programme is officially recognised by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport (MoEYS) as equivalent to the national high school diploma.

What is Diploma Equivalency?

Diploma equivalency means that Paragon ISC's Secondary Education Diploma is officially recognised by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport (MoEYS) as equivalent to the Grade 12 National Diploma. Students who complete this diploma are exempt from sitting the Grade 12 National Examinations.











DIPLOMA PATHWAYS AND EQUIVALENCY

Higher Education & Employment Opportunities

- •Higher Education: Qualifies students for admission to both national and international universities.
- •Employment: Recognised for job applications in public and private sectors within Cambodia and internationally.

Programme Requirements for Equivalency

To earn an equivalency diploma, students must complete the International Programme in high school.

Differences Between International and Bilingual Programmes

International Programme:

- Based on the Cambridge International Curriculum.
- All courses are taught in English, with an option to study a foreign language.
- Local students must complete Khmer Language, Khmer History, and Culture classes to qualify for diploma equivalency.

Bilingual Programme:

- Includes all **National Curriculum** subjects taught in Khmer, along with a minimum number of Cambridge subjects taught in English.
- Students must pass the **Grade 6**, **Grade 9**, **and Grade 12 National Examinations** and complete **12 years of schooling** to earn a **National Diploma**.

Examinations for International Programme Students

Students in the International Programme:

- Are **exempt** from the Grade 6, Grade 9, and Grade 12 National Examinations.
- Take **school-based summative exams** for their Cambridge courses.
- Have their **Grade 12 results submitted to MoEYS** for approval of the equivalency diploma.

For students wishing to obtain **Cambridge qualifications**, they must register for and take **Cambridge Examinations** in their chosen subjects.

Eligibility & Registration

- Eligibility: Students may register for the programme at any grade level, starting from primary school.
- Registration: Visit or contact the school reception to complete the registration process.

Programme Fees

There are differences in fees between the Bilingual and International Programmes. Detailed information can be obtained from the school office.

Switching Programmes

- •Allowed: Students may switch from the bilingual programme to the international programme at the end of the academic year.
- •Not Allowed: Students enrolled in the international programme cannot switch to the bilingual programme, as it may affect their alignment with the national curriculum levels and their eligibility for the National Exam in Grades 9 and 12.




SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ART, AND MATH



TESTING CENTRES



Paragon ISC is proud to be an **authorised Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) examination centre** (Test Centre Code: **KH006 & KH009**), offering world-class qualifications that prepare students for academic and professional success.

Cambridge International provides globally recognised examinations to over **10,000 schools in more than 160 countries**, equipping students with the knowledge and skills necessary for higher education and beyond. At Paragon ISC, students have access to **Cambridge IGCSE and A-Level qualifications**, which serve as a strong foundation for university entrance worldwide. Additionally, we facilitate **Key Stage examinations** for primary and secondary students, ensuring a seamless academic progression.

As a **Cambridge-authorised test centre**, we also welcome **private candidates** for all levels of Cambridge examinations, reinforcing our commitment to providing high-quality international education in Cambodia.



The Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions. It is a three-hour multiple-choice test created and administered by the College Board. It covers reading, writing, and math and is used to determine students' preparedness for college. The SAT is held seven times a year, typically on the first Saturday of the month.

Paragon International School's Secondary campus, situated between the Russian Embassy and the AEON Mall 1 buildings, serves as the SAT centre with the assigned test centre number 65394. The address is on Street 3, Sangkat Tonle Basak, Khan Chamkar Morn, Phnom Penh



Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing offers a variety of admissions tests for university-level courses, including assessments of thinking skills and behavioural styles. Through our centre, candidates have the option to register for the following examinations:

- BMAT (BioMedical Admissions Test)
- Test of Mathematics for University Admission (TMUA)
- MAT (Mathematics Admissions Test)
- University of Oxford admissions tests (CAT, Oxford ELAT, HAT, MLAT, OLAT, PAT, TSA, Philosophy test)





CAT4 (Cognitive Abilities Test)

At Paragon ISC, we strive to ensure that every student is placed in an academic environment where they can thrive. As part of our admissions process, we administer the Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4) to assess students' learning potential and cognitive strengths. This standardised assessment evaluates key areas such as verbal, non-verbal, quantitative, and spatial reasoning, providing valuable insights into a student's ability to process information and solve problems. The results help our educators tailor learning approaches to support each student's academic development, ensuring they receive the best possible educational experience at Paragon ISC.


SCHOOL INFORMATION SYSTEM (SIS)




ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Admission to Paragon International School Cambodia is based on whether the school and its programmes can meet a student's educational needs. Students can be enrolled in the school throughout the year, but admission will also depend on the spaces available for grades and classes. Admission for toddlers to the school's Kindergarten will be open twice a year. It is important to remember that the busiest enrolment period for the next academic year, which begins in August, is in March

It is important that the application for enrolment to Paragon ISC is submitted in full with the supporting documents required by the school. Application forms can be obtained through the Paragon ISC website or by visiting one of the school's three campuses.

Steps to Apply



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Documents Needed:

- •Two recent photos (4"x6") of the student; one photo of each parent.
- •Copy of the student's passport, birth certificate, and parent's ID.
- Previous school records for the past two years (translated into English if necessary).
- •Grade 6 or 9 National Exam completion certificate for bilingual programme students.
- •Health history, including proof of immunisation.
- •Signed parental and fee policy agreements.
- •Recommendation letter from the previous school (can be emailed directly to Paragon ISC).

Placement Test & Language Proficiency:

•Students must take a placement test in English (and Khmer for bilingual programme) to determine their eligibility and appropriate educational track.

Behavioural and Academic Standards:

- •Adherence to Paragon ISC's code of conduct and academic policies is mandatory.
- •Students must reside with a parent or legal guardian, and tuition fees must be paid according to the school's fee policy.
